91st Days for 2012

Here is a quick synopsis of the 91st Days for 2012.

The final 91st Days for the 2011 solar year will be March 18 and 19th, 2011. The Spring Equinox (Tuesday, March 20, 2012) is the beginning of the 2012 solar year (it is the first day of Abib, day 1). Monday, April 2, 2012 is the Passover for 2012 (the 14th day of Abib).

Following Passover Day, there are four 91st Days, which are like Soldier Sabbaths and likened as the four fingers on a hand. Passover is likened as the "thumb day".

Each day begins at high noon (remember to adjust for Daylight Savings Time). (*For more information on the day beginning at noon, we suggest our 4 part series "The Sabbath", available on CD.*)

We suggest you read and pray the 91st Psalms on these 91st Days, and observe these days as Sabbaths.

These Soldier Sabbaths are in addition to the regular 7th day "Lord's Day" observed by the early Church and by Christians today. If you simply cannot observe these 91st Days Sabbaths, the truth of Romans 8:1 is still the promise to the Christian.

The following are the dates for the 91st Days for calendar year 2012.

June 18, 2012 September 17, 2012

December 17, 2012

We realize it will only be the "remnant of the remnant" that Pastor Peters calls the "Barley first-fruit Gideon force" that takes seriously the 91st Days teachings.
